Puzzling Path

Behold the Fleming cannon! The cannon, operated by students of Fleming Hovse, fires at the end of rotation and the end of the academic year, marking when pre-first years become first years and juniors become seniors. Rotation, traditionally taking place at the beginning of the academic year, is where the new Caltech undergraduates rotate through Caltech's eight Houses to decide which ones they are most interested in being a part of or if they would rather remain unaffiliated. After the Fleming cannon fires, the now-officially first years receive their House or unaffiliated status assignments. Can you help the new Techers find their way to their residences?

IMPORTANT: DO NOT TOUCH THE CANNON. You do not want to know why.

In each of the following puzzles, the beavers in the pair of grids move together, with the exception of moving into a wall, which will keep a beaver in the same space. A move consists of moving one cell up, down, left, or right (or staying in the same spot if that direction is blocked by a wall). You must use exactly the number of moves provided. Each puzzle has a unique sequence of steps that will take the beavers to their end destination.

Example: 4 moves

Avery House: 4 moves

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Blacker House: 4 moves

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Dabney House: 4 moves

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Fleming House: 4 moves

Lloyd House: 4 moves

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Page House: 5 moves

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Ricketts House: 5 moves

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Venerable House: 5 moves

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Bechtel Residence: 5 moves
